Where are we located?

Fort Yukon is located about 150 miles from Fairbanks. The only way in or out, in the winter, is by airplane. In the summer, the nearest road to Fairbanks is in Circle (90 miles up the Yukon River).

Fort Yukon is home to 600 people, most of whom are Gwich'in Athabaskan Native Alaskans. The Yukon Flats region hosts 7 other Athabaskan villages, some with no church at all. This region holds the Alaskan record for high temps (100°F) in the summer and just a few degrees shy of the cold record (-80°F) in the winter.
