The Faithful One

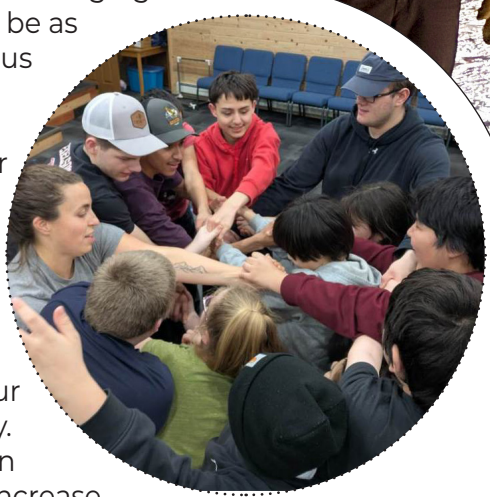
“God is faithful, who has called you into fellowship with his Son, Jesus Christ our Lord.” - 1 Corinthians 1:9
