I hope you have been having a terrific summer! Up here, in Fort Yukon, Alaska, God has been leading us through some amazing events.

A few days into June, we headed upriver to Circle City (about 90 river miles) to assist **This Generation Ministries** in hauling supplies and equipment to Camp Nahshii (a Christian youth camp, located 60 miles downriver from Fort Yukon). Overall, this supply run consisted of 240 river miles and 17 hours of boating. And that was just to kick off the camp. Throughout the following 6 weeks, we would do many more hours on the river (about 60, total).

This year, I was privileged to take on the position of Camp Director. It was alot of hard work, but well worth it. This year, we had 42 students in our 2 camps. Many of these youth had genuine, life changing encounters with Jesus Christ.

Thank you for your continual investment into our lives and ministry. Without your support, we wouldn't have the fuel, equipment, safety gear, and supplies needed to be a part of things like Camp Nahshii.
